## THE CALLEEN ART AWARD

The Calleen Art Award encourages originality, creativity and artistic excellence. The Calleen Art Award is an acquisitive national painting prize in any subject and style established in 1977 by Patricia Fagan OAM. The winner of the 2017 Calleen Art Award will receive \$20,000 in prize money made possible by the generous support of the Calleen Trust and the winning work will become part of the Calleen Collection at the Cowra Regional Art Gallery.

Announcement of the 2017 Calleen Art Award winner will take place at the Official Opening on 6 May 2017. Exhibition dates are 7 May to Sunday 18 June 2017.

## PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD

The People's Choice Award is non-acquisitive and awarded at the end of the exhibition. The winner will receive \$500.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Submission of an entry is and shall constitute acceptance of all the following conditions of entry. The entrant is bound by and shall perform and observe all obligations within these conditions.

### ELIGIBILITY

1. Entry into the Calleen Art Award is open to persons over 18 years, living and working in Australia. Entries must be the original work of the submitting artist and only works completed since 1 January 2016 will be considered.
2. The winner of the 2017 Calleen Art Award agrees said work shall become the property of the Cowra Regional Art Gallery and part of the Calleen Collection.
3. All work entered into the Calleen Art Award must not have been shown previously in any other art prize/competition in the Central West Region of NSW including Bathurst/Cowra/Lithgow/ Mudgee/Orange/Parks/Young.
4. By entering a work into the Calleen Art Award the artist warrants that said work does not infringe copyright, moral rights or other rights of a third party.
5. Each work entered must be accompanied by a fee of \$33.00 (non-refundable). A work entered without payment of an entry fee will not be considered eligible. Payment can be made as a cheque or money order made payable to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery or by credit card as set out in the Entry Form.
6. An artist may enter up to three (3) works in total for consideration. No third party or commercial gallery may enter works on behalf of an artist.
7. All work as listed on this entry form must be for sale. The Gallery commission for a work sold during the finalist exhibition is 33% of the price as listed. The artist is responsible for all other costs/commissions/payments as required.
8. All work entered (including a diptych or triptych) must be no greater than 2m (200cm) x 2m (200cm) in size and 40kg in weight.
9. All work entered must not be owned by a third party and the entry form must be signed by the artist as the owner of the work.
10. A completed entry form must include on CD or USB an artist statement - max of 200 words per entry and digital images of each work in the following formats:
  - Up to three digital images per artwork in a JPEG file format of no less than 300dpi and file size no less than 1 MB and no larger than 3MB
  - Files should be clearly named with the artist's surname and first initial followed by the name of the artwork and size. Eg Jones B. Untitled 90cm (w) x 150cm (h). NOTE: All entry information including submitted CD's or USB's will be retained by the Gallery for archival purposes.
  - Images submitted must be of professional quality for reproduction purposes. Include photography credit if required.
11. A completed Entry Form together with entry fee, artists statement and digital image/s must be submitted to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery, 77 Darling Street, Cowra, NSW, 2794 by **4pm on Friday 3 March 2017**. Late or incomplete entries will not be eligible. NB: All entries including support material are to be submitted and delivered without charges. The Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, and/or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council will not be responsible for the loss or damage of an entry form and/or support material.

### JUDGING AND PRE-SELECTION

12. There are two rounds of judging. Exhibition finalists will be selected from all the entries received by a pre-selection panel designated by the Director, Cowra Regional Art Gallery.
13. The Panel and Award Judge's decision for the Calleen Art Award is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
14. Calleen Art Award finalists' will be notified by email after the pre-selection process is completed in mid March 2017. The complete list will be published on the Gallery website at the end of March 2017.
15. The announcement of 2017 Calleen Art Award winner will be made at the exhibition opening on Saturday 6 May 2017.
16. Only Calleen Art Award finalists will be required to deliver their work to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery. A substitute for a selected work will not be accepted.

### FINALISTS' INFORMATION

17. A selected work for exhibition must be ready for hanging with D-rings securely attached to the main stretcher frame of the work 10cm from the top of the frame for a large work and 5cm for the top for a smaller work (do not attach hanging wire or hooks etc). A stretched canvas is considered framed for display in this instance.
  18. Works selected for exhibition must be delivered to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery between 24 -28 April 2017 or 1-2 May 2017 (no deliveries on a public holiday or weekend) from 10am and 5pm. The Gallery should be contacted on (02) 6340 2190 confirming the delivery of a work selected for exhibition by hand, post or courier at least 7 days before delivery.
- Please Note:** Cowra Regional Art Gallery has organised a special freight arrangement for artists selected for exhibition with International Art Services (IAS). Works selected for exhibition can be sent to either the IAS depot in Sydney or Queanbeyan and from there they will be forwarded to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery at no cost to the artist. Works will also be

returned to the same depot at no cost to the artist at the end of the exhibition. In the first instance an artist selected for exhibition must organise the delivery of their work securely packaged (at their own cost) to the IAS depot in Sydney or Queanbeyan **no later than Friday 21 April 2017**. Further information will be sent to artists selected for exhibition following their notification as a finalist.

19. If consigning a work via post, the correct amount of stamps for the return postage must be included with the work when posted to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery. If the work is sold, the said stamps will be returned to the artist if requested.

21. A work selected for exhibition must be securely packaged in bubble wrap and cardboard packaging to ensure safe transportation to the Gallery. The packaging must be suitable for the Gallery to re-use for the return of the work. A label or copy of the entry form must be attached to the back of the said work with the following information: artist name, title, date, dimensions, medium contact telephone number and return delivery address

### INSURANCE

- Each artist is and shall be responsible for maintaining their own insurance. All postal, transit/freight insurance arrangements and costs are borne by the artist.
- The Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council will accept no liability for the loss of an entry or damage to a work selected for exhibition.
- The Gallery will exercise all reasonable care of a work selected for exhibition from time of receipt to the collection date, however, the entrant agrees to indemnify the Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council against the loss or damage of said work during this period.

### SALE OF A WORK SELECTED FOR EXHIBITION AND PAYMENT

- The sale price on the entry form shall remain fixed for the duration of the exhibition. Should a work selected for exhibition be sold (excluding the winning work) the net sale proceeds will be paid to the artist after receiving an invoice from the artist for the net amount within thirty-five (35) days of sale, provided settlement has been made in accordance with the conditions of sale.
- A work sold during the exhibition will not be released until the exhibition ends, and full payment has been received by the Gallery from the purchaser. All costs for additional packaging and transit/freight relating to a sold work is the responsibility of the purchaser and/or artist.

### COPYRIGHT AND PROMOTION

- Artists grant Cowra Regional Art Gallery and its licensees the right to reproduce digital images submitted with the entry form and their biographical material in any media for archival, catalogue and/or promotional purposes.
- Artists warrant they agree to indemnify the Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council for any breach or infringement of copyright.
- An artist selected for exhibition agrees that their work can be photographed during the exhibition dates by the staff and or agents of Cowra Regional Art Gallery and published in any print, electronic or digital format for marketing, educational and review purposes.
- An artist selected as the winner of the 2017 Calleen Art Award agrees that their winning work can be photographed by the staff and or agents of Cowra Regional Art Gallery and published in any print, electronic or digital format for marketing, educational and review purposes in relation to the Calleen Collection from the completion of the exhibition.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

The information requested on this form is required for the administration of said awards and will only be used for this purpose (and where applicable for the ongoing administration of said awards). This information cannot be accessed by any unauthorised person.

In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of the terms and conditions, the decision of the Director of the Cowra Regional Art Gallery shall be binding on all parties.

Unless the contrary intention appears in the wording of this form, words in the singular number include the plural and words in the plural number include the singular. Also, the word Gallery refers to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery and the word work in the context of this entry form refers to a painting.
