### THE CALLEEN ART AWARD

The Calleen Art Award is an acquisitive art prize that encourages originality and artistic merit established in 1977 by Mrs Patricia Fagan OAM.

The winner of the 2018 Calleen Art Award will receive \$20,000 in prize money made possible by the generosity of the Calleen Trust. A painting is selected as a finalist by a selection panel of art professionals and the winning painting will become part of the Calleen Collection at the Cowra Regional Art Gallery.

The announcement of the 2018 Calleen Art Award winner will not be made until the Official Opening of the finalist's exhibition on Saturday 5 May 2018.

### PEOPLE'S CHOICE AWARD

A People's Choice Award (non-acquisitive) is awarded at the end of the exhibition. The winner will receive \$500.

## CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

Submission of an entry is and shall constitute acceptance of all the following conditions of the Entry. The entrant (Artist) is bound by and shall perform and observe all obligations pursuant to these conditions.

### 1. ELIGIBILITY

The Calleen Art Award is open to persons over 18 years, living and professionally based in Australia.

Eligible entries must be a painting (in any style and subject) wholly executed using a painting medium (oil, acrylic, watercolour) and no greater than 2 x 2 metres or equivalent size/area ratio—including a diptych or triptych. A painting must be designed to hang on or be fixed to a wall (see Finalists' Information for more details). All other media are ineligible.

Only a painting that is the original work and concept of the artist and completed since 1 January 2017 will be considered. All paintings submitted must be available for sale in the exhibition and must not be owned by a third party.

The painting awarded the 2018 Calleen Art Award will automatically become part of the Calleen Collection upon payment of the prize money to the winning entrant.

By entering a painting into the Calleen Art Award the artist warrants that said painting does not infringe copyright, moral rights or other rights of a third party.

A painting entered into the Calleen Art Award must not have been shown previously in any other art prize/competition in the Central West Region of NSW.

Awards of cash prizes are deemed inclusive of any requisite GST amount. The Gallery reserves the right to reject an entry where insufficient GST information is given.

An artist or their authorised sole agent or commercial gallery may enter up to three (3) paintings in total for consideration. Each painting entered must be accompanied by a non-refundable fee of \$33.00 (including GST) together with the support material and the Calleen Art Award entry form signed by the Artist. A painting entered for selection without the correct payment (including correct credit card information if relevant) will not be considered eligible (see the *Entry Form* for more information). Artists or their authorised sole agent or commercial gallery are liable for all GST payable including fees, support material, postage, insurance and freight as required.

### 2. SUBMISSION INFORMATION

Artists are required to submit the following:

1. A completed entry form signed by the artist with ABN or Statement by supplier form
2. Fee Payment (\$33 per entry) by cheque, money order or credit card (see entry form)
3. Digital image of each entry on a CD or USB Thumb Drive as a JPEG file—no less than 300dpi and a file size 2–5 MB. Images must include at least one complete image of each painting entered for selection and no more than two detail images (optional). Images submitted must be of professional quality for reproduction purposes. Include photography credit if required.
4. An artist statement/description (MS Word or PDF) of each painting entered for selection, about 200 words per entry. Please include on the same CD or USB Thumb Drive with the digital image.

*Note: Files of each digital image submitted should be clearly named with the artist's surname and first initial followed by the name of the painting and size, e.g. Jones B. Untitled, 90cm (w) x 150cm (h). NOTE: All entry information submitted including CD's or USB's will be retained by the Gallery for archival purposes.*

A completed Entry Form together with entry fee, artist statement and digital image/s must be submitted to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery, 77 Darling Street, Cowra, NSW, 2794 by **4pm on Friday 2 March 2018**. Late or incomplete entries will not be eligible. NB: All entries including support material are to be submitted and delivered without charges. The Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, and/or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council will not be responsible for the loss or damage of an entry form and/or support material.

### 3. PRICING AND SALE OF A PAINTING

The Cowra Regional Art Gallery is authorised to offer any selected painting in the exhibition for sale to the public at the price (inclusive of GST if any) endorsed on the entry form. The sale price on the entry form shall remain fixed for the duration of the exhibition.

If sold from the exhibition a selected painting is subject to a commission of 33% (incl. GST) by the Gallery. In the case where the artist has been represented by a sole agent or commercial gallery within Australia for more than a year the Cowra Regional Art Gallery will share the commission with the sole agent or commercial gallery of the artist.

Should a painting be sold the net sale proceeds will be paid to the artist within thirty-five (35) days of sale, provided settlement has been made in accordance with the conditions of sale. A painting sold during the exhibition will not be released until the exhibition ends, and full payment has been received by the Gallery. All costs for additional packaging and transit/freight relating to a sold painting is the responsibility of the purchaser and/or artist or the artist's sole agent or commercial gallery. Payment will be made in Australian dollars.

### 4. JUDGING AND PRE-SELECTION

There are two rounds of judging. Exhibition finalists will be pre-selected from the digital images received by a panel of art professionals designated by the Director, Cowra Regional Art Gallery.

The pre-selection panel and the Award Judge's decision for the Calleen Art Award are final and no correspondence will be entered into. A decision by a majority of the pre-selection panel judges on any issue shall be deemed to be a valid and binding decision of the panel as a whole.

Calleen Art Award 2018 finalists will be notified by email. The complete list of finalists will be published on the Gallery website at the end of March 2018. Non finalists will be notified by mail.

The announcement of 2018 Calleen Art Award winner will be made at the exhibition opening on Saturday 5 May 2018.

Only Calleen Art Award finalists will be required to deliver their painting to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery. A substitute for a selected painting will not be accepted.

### 5. FINALISTS' INFORMATION

A selected painting for exhibition must be ready for hanging with D-rings securely attached to the main stretcher frame 10cm from the top of the frame for a large painting and 5cm for the top for a smaller painting (do not attach hanging wire or hooks, etc.). A stretched canvas is considered framed for display in this instance.

Paintings selected for exhibition must be delivered to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery between **26–27 April 2018** or **30 April–1 May 2018** from 10am and 4.30pm (no deliveries on a public holiday or weekend). The Gallery should be contacted on (02) 6340 2190 or email [cwraartgallery@cowra.nsw.gov.au](mailto:cwraartgallery@cowra.nsw.gov.au) confirming the delivery of a painting selected for exhibition by hand, post or courier at least 7 days before delivery.

**IAS freight assistance** – Cowra Regional Art Gallery has a special freight arrangement for paintings selected for exhibition with International Art Services (IAS). Selected paintings will be forwarded to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery at no cost to the artist if the painting is delivered to the IAS depot in Sydney or Queanbeyan no later than Tuesday 24 April 2018. Paintings will also be returned to the same depot at no cost to the artist at the end of the exhibition. In the first instance an artist selected for exhibition must organise the delivery of their painting, at their own cost, to the IAS depot in Sydney or Queanbeyan before the said date. Further information and will be sent to artists selected for exhibition following their notification as a finalist.

If consigning a painting via post, the correct amount of stamps for the return postage must be included with the painting when posted to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery. If the said painting is sold, the stamps will be returned to the artist if requested.

### 6. INSURANCE

The Cowra Regional Art Gallery, its staff, or agents, and the Cowra Shire Council shall not be responsible or liable for any loss or damage whatsoever, however caused, to any painting whilst in the custody of the Gallery. Each artist is and shall be the responsible for maintaining their own insurance cover. All postal, transit/freight insurance arrangements and costs are borne by the artist.

### 7. COPYRIGHT AND PROMOTION

If selected for exhibition the artist agrees to grant Cowra Regional Art Gallery and its licensees the right to the reproduction of the painting or detail of the painting (at no fee) based on the digital image/s submitted and their exhibition statement in all publications (catalogues, folders, posters, slide shows, brochures, invitations etc) and any social media for archival, catalogue and/or promotional purposes related to the Calleen Art Award.

An artist agrees that their painting selected for exhibition can be photographed during the exhibition dates by the staff and or agents of Cowra Regional Art Gallery and published in any print, electronic or digital format for marketing, educational and review purposes.

If selected as the winner of the 2018 Calleen Art Award the artist agrees that their winning painting can be photographed by the staff and or agents of Cowra Regional Art Gallery and published in any print, electronic or digital format for marketing, educational and review purposes in relation to the Calleen Collection from the completion of the exhibition.

### 8. GENERAL INFORMATION

The information requested on this form is required for the administration of the Calleen Art Award and will only be used for this purpose (and where applicable for the ongoing administration of said awards). This information cannot be accessed by any unauthorised person.

In the event of a dispute regarding the interpretation of the terms and conditions, the decision of the Director of the Cowra Regional Art Gallery shall be binding on all parties.

Unless the contrary intention appears in the wording of this form, words in the singular number include the plural and words in the plural number include the singular. Also, the word Gallery refers to the Cowra Regional Art Gallery and the word work in the context of this entry form refers to a painting.
